



ELEVENTH CHARACTER



THE BOY WITH 5 LOAVES (John 6 vs 1-15)



One faithful day, thousands of people came from afar to listen to the famous Jesus, and a little boy also came along with them. They all sat with Jesus for a long time, listening to him teach. By evening time, They were already hungry and some of them didn't have any food.



The little boy had some food with him, but instead of keeping it for himself, he decided to share it with everyone, or as many people as it could feed. So he went to the disciples and showed them what he had. When the disciples saw the boy's small amount of food, they thought it wasn't enough to feed that amount of people.



“This boy only has five loaves and two fish,” said one of the disciples to Jesus. But Jesus took the food from them, gave thanks to God, and began to distribute it to the people. And in his hands, the food multiplied. (vs 10-11) The little boy must have been surprised when he saw his small amount of food feed so many people. Everyone ate until they were full, and there were even leftovers that filled up twelve large baskets!



Even though the name of this little boy was not mentioned, his story teaches us that kids like you can do big things with Jesus. No matter how little you have, if you give it to Jesus, he can make it more and help lots of people.



From merely five loaves of bread to feeding thousands of people and finally filling up twelve baskets with leftovers. We can do something very big like feeding thousands of people, with something very little like five loaves and two fish, as long as it is in the hands of Jesus.
