


# FIFTH CHARACTER

**(DANIEL 6 VS 19-28)**






**Among the young slaves who were selected by the king to serve in the palace was a man named Daniel. Daniel loved God very much. Even though he was far from home, he kept praying to God every day. Some people didn't like Daniel because he loved God. They wanted to hurt him.**

**"What kind of punishment can we give to this man called Daniel"** they asked among themselves, and then they agreed to put him in a den of lions. These lions were very hungry and fierce. They could pounce on anyone who dared to come into their den, Tearing the flesh from the bones.
